Montpelier is the lifelong home of James Madison, Father of the Constitution, architect of the Bill of Rights, and president of the United States.

Now that the home's recent \$25 million architectural restoration is complete, visitors can see the progress of "A Presidential Detective Story: Rediscovering the Furnishings and Décor of James and Dolley Madison" through daily guided tours. They can also participate in hands-on activities, and archaeology; leisurely stroll the garden and forests; take in the galleries and many other attractions on the estate's 2,650 acres.

Nestled in the rolling foothills of the Blue Ridge Mountains, Montpelier is located in the heart of Virginia's wine country on Route 20, four miles south of Orange, Va. Montpelier is a National Trust Historic Site. To learn more, visit
