### THE DILLARD HOUSE

It's the epicenter of Southern cooking, a title earned by love of land since the American Revolution. The Dillard House is American heartland, a place to go to learn about beginnings, where the spirit of Lieutenant John Dillard who fought with the Virginia troops lingers. Rewarded by George Washington for his effort with a 1000-acre grant of land in then unexplored lands, John came, built and lived in peace raising a family that bears his proud name today.

John Dillard-today's version-oversees the shrine of food and lodging just below the North Carolina border. Although it's an easy drive to Atlanta, the Dillard House is more akin to earlier pioneer days, particularly at mealtime. Country ham, homemade sausage, fried chicken that can't be duplicated, fresh vegetables from the bounty of nearby farms are served with big smiles and genuine warmth.

The Dillard House is an experience that remains in the recesses of memory where good things are never forgotten. Breakfast, lunch or dinner share equal footing. No shortcuts, just dishes served with lots of love and unequalled tradition.

Eat, laugh and enjoy. You are in the midst of greatness.

After the final bite, take those you love to the grounds behind the dining room to the old cemetery beside the headwaters of the Little Tennessee River. Finding Lieutenant John Dillard's grave is easy. You'll know it when you see the Great Seal of the United States on the memorial.

Reflect in a spirit of thanksgiving, proud that even today his descendants bring guests from the four corners to Rabun County and share mountain hospitality around their legendary dinner table.
